Although the University started initially with just two faculties, the Faculty of Humanities and the Faculty of Fisheries, since then, it has grown into a major research level institution covering all the major disciplines within academia. ## **Busan New Port**

The 4th largest container terminal in the world is located in the Southeast of the South Korean peninsula at Pusan. As the old port is completely surrounded by the Pusan metropolitan area, expansion of the old port is restricted. To solve chronic cargo congestion, the Korean government decided to construct a new port situated 20 km west of Pusan with a final total handling capacity of 4.6 million TEU. Busan New

Port was constructed in a naturally sheltered area behind Gadukdo Island. Samsung contracted for the development of four portions of the new port development.
